Reading the newspaper a few days ago I thought, not for the first time, how nearly all the news is bad and gives us yet more to worry about. There's inflation, last week's heatwave (if it lasted long enough to warrant the name) the number of Covid cases on the rise, the war in Ukraine and no doubt other things as well. I suppose bad news sells more papers, or perhaps gets more online hits, but the fact remains that there's a lot of worrying things happening.

As you might expect, I tend to pray when I'm worried about something. I ask God to sort things out, and, in my mind, I have a picture of exactly what type of solution I want him to bring about. But I'm afraid God is not a personal Father Christmas to any of us, and sometimes his solution is not the one I imagined.

I don't think for a moment that God is incapable of giving me exactly what I want, that he doesn't care about me or that he wants me to be unhappy. But God has a broader and deeper view than I have. He sees, not just what is good for me, but what is good for every human being. And his idea of what is good me is different from mine as well, because he sees my long term good, and what will help me to grow, rather than just my short-term pleasure or comfort.

Please pray, for yourself and the wider world. But if God's answer to your prayer doesn't seem to be quite what you had in mind, try to remember his deeper and broader perspective. Trust him; he loves you.
